
# **Robot** operation



Attach the floating cable to the power supply.

6 Cleaning the filter

 $\triangle$  Unplug the power supply before servicing

Put the Pool Cleaner into the pool. Release the Pool Cleaner and let it sink to the floor of the pool. Make sure that the floating cable is free of any obstructions.



Turn the power supply ON. The Pool Cleaner will now operate until it has reached the end of the cleaning cycle.

Coil the cable and store in a cool, dry place on the Caddy.


Do NOT store the robot where it will be exposed to direct sunlight, excessive heat or to frost.


## Periodic filter cleaning

Dismantle the 4 ultra-fine filter panels of the outer basket according to the following steps:




Dismantle the panels, starting with pressing on panel no.1 using your
